



Floyd D. Loop, M.D. Retired Chairman and CEO, The Cleveland Clinic Foundation



Floyd Loop, M.D., retired as the chief executive officer and chairman of the board of governors of The Cleveland Clinic Foundation in October 2004, a position he held for 15 years.

Before becoming the Foundation's chief executive officer in 1989, Dr. Loop was an internationally recognized cardiac surgeon. He practiced cardiothoracic surgery for 30 years and headed the Department of Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery at The Cleveland Clinic from 1975

to 1989.

Dr. Loop has authored more than 350 clinical research papers, chaired the Residency Review Committee for Thoracic Surgery and was president of the American Association for Thoracic Surgery.

He is a director of two other public companies, Athersys, Inc. and Intuitive Surgical, Inc.

Dr. Loop received his medical degree from George Washington University and received his bachelor's degree from Purdue University.

Dr. Loop has been a member of Tenet's board of directors since January 1999.
