

J. McDonald Williams Retired Chairman, Trammell Crow Company



J. McDonald Williams served as the chairman of Trammell Crow Company from 1994 until May 2002. Prior to serving in that role, he was the company's president and chief executive officer from 1990 to 1994 and was managing partner from 1977 to 1990.

Williams currently serves as a director of one other public company, A. H. Belo Corporation.

In 1995, Williams founded the Foundation for Community Empowerment to assist in redeveloping low-income neighborhoods in Dallas. He also serves on the boards of a number of foundations, including the Hoblitzelle Foundation.

Williams is a member of the Leadership Council of the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center and is a trustee of Dallas Medical Resource.

Williams received his L.L.B. from George Washington University Law School and his bachelor's degree from Abilene Christian University.

Williams has been on Tenet's board of directors since March 2005.
