



James A. Unruh Principal, Alerion Capital Group LLC



James Unruh has served as principal of Alerion Capital Group LLC, a private equity firm, since 1998.

Prior to founding Alerion, he was the chairman, president and chief executive officer of Unisys Corporation from 1990 until 1997, where he is credited with restructuring the company's business portfolio, re-engineering its cost structure and overseeing organizational and cultural changes. Under his leadership, Unisys became a financially revitalized, globally-recognized information technology and services company with \$6.6 billion in

revenue. Prior to being appointed chief executive officer, Mr. Unruh held a number of positions of increasing responsibility at Unisys and its predecessor corporation, Burroughs Corporation.

Earlier in his career he was instrumental in leading turn-arounds at Fairchild Camera and Instrument Corporation and Memorex Corporation, where he served as chief financial officer for both companies. He also authored a book on customer dedication, *Customers Mean Business*, in 1990.

Mr. Unruh has been a director of nearly a dozen Fortune 500 corporations and has extensive experience in marketing, finance and management. Mr. Unruh is a director of four public companies: Tenet Healthcare Corporation (NYSE:THC), CSG Systems International, Inc. (NASDAQ:CSGS), Prudential Financial, Inc. (NYSE:PRU) and CenturyLink, Inc. (NYSE:CTL).

He received his bachelor's degree in business administration from Jamestown College and his master's degree in business administration from the University of Denver.

Mr. Unruh was elected to Tenet's board of directors in June 2004. He chairs the Audit Committee and is a member of the Health IT Committee and the Nominating and Corporate Governance Committee.
