

John Ellis “Jeb” Bush Former Florida Governor



Jeb Bush is the president of Jeb Bush and Associates, a consulting firm. He served as the 43rd governor of the state of Florida from January 1999 until January 2007.

Prior to his election as governor, Mr. Bush worked as a real estate executive and pursued other entrepreneurial ventures in Florida from 1981 to 1998, and served as Florida’s Secretary of Commerce from 1987 to 1988.

Before 1981, Bush served in various positions at Texas Commerce Bank in Houston, Texas and in Caracas, Venezuela. He formed and serves as chairman of the Foundation for Florida’s Future, a not-for-profit public policy organization, and the Foundation for Excellence in Education, a not-for-profit charitable organization.

Mr. Bush currently serves on the board of directors of one other public company, Rayonier Inc.

He holds a bachelor’s degree in Latin American affairs from the University of Texas at Austin.

Mr. Bush has been a member of Tenet’s board of directors since April 2007.
