



## Edward A. Kangas Retired Chairman and CEO, Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu



Edward A. Kangas serves as the non-executive chairman of the board for Tenet Healthcare Corporation.

Prior to his association with Tenet, Mr. Kangas was global chairman and chief executive officer of Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu where he designed and led the integration of a worldwide firm that today has revenue of \$23 billion and more than 150,000 employees in 100 countries. During his tenure as chairman from 1989 – 2000, the firm's revenue grew from \$3.5 billion to \$11 billion. He also was one of the chief architects of the firm's merger with Deloitte Haskins & Sells in 1989. From 1989 to 1994, he served as Managing Partner of Deloitte & Touche (USA), spearheading the merger integration of the firm's U.S. operations. Mr. Kangas also spent five years as the National Director of Management Consulting, now known as Deloitte Consulting. Prior to that, Mr. Kangas was managing partner and chief executive officer of Touche Ross, where he began his career as a staff accountant in 1967. In his 33 years with the firm, Mr. Kangas developed expertise in financial and strategic consulting, auditing, and corporate finance.

In addition to his role as chairman at Tenet, Mr. Kangas is a director of four other public companies: Allscripts Healthcare Solutions (NASDAQ: MDRX), Hovnanian Enterprises, Inc. (NYSE:HOV), Intuit, Inc. (NASDAQ:INTU) and United Technologies Corporation (NYSE:UTX).

He is also a board member of the International Federation of Multiple Sclerosis Societies, a \$250 million health agency, and he serves as a trustee of the Committee for Economic Development, a Washington, D.C.-based public policy group. Mr. Kangas is a member of Beta Gamma Sigma Directors' Table and a life trustee of the board of trustees of the University of Kansas Endowment Association.

Mr. Kangas was named to *The Directorship 100*, a list of the most influential players in corporate governance in 2007 and 2008, and was recognized in 2007 as an *Outstanding Director* by the Outstanding Directors Exchange.

A certified public accountant, Mr. Kangas holds a master's degree and bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Kansas, where he was honored with the university's *Distinguished Alumni Award* in 2000.

Mr. Kangas has been a member of Tenet's board of directors since April 2003 and was first elected chairman of the board in July 2003. He is Chair of the Executive Committee and Compensation Committee and a member of the Health IT Committee and the Quality, Compliance and Ethics Committee.
