Atlanta Medical Center is located at 303 Parkway Drive in Atlanta. Atlanta Medical Center has been serving the medical needs of the community and region since its founding in 1901.

Specialties include advanced surgery, bariatric (weight loss) surgery, cardiology, neurology, oncology, women's health, orthopedics, trauma, hyperbaric wound care, bloodless medicine and rehabilitation. The Regional Level II trauma center is supported by aeromedical services providing immediate transportation to critical patients throughout the state.

The hospital campus is home to Surgical Associates of AMC, Internal Medicine Associates of Atlanta Medical Center, which includes treatment for diabetes and Hepatitis C, and the Wellness Center, which houses the Highland Athletic Club and outpatient rehabilitation program.
