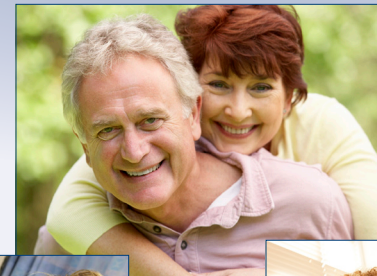

\*"Transfusion free" means medical or surgical treatment without the use of banked (stored) allogeneic blood or primary blood components. Blood loss often occurs during surgery. A transfusion-free program endeavors to minimize blood loss by utilizing special blood conservation methods.
